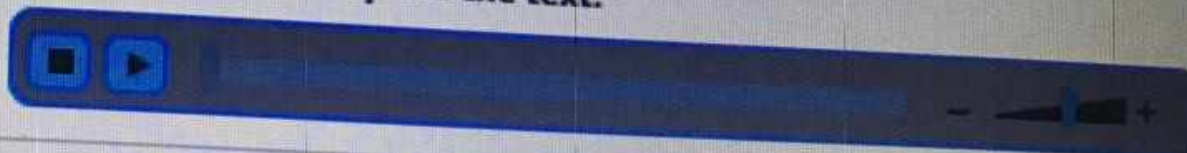


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Listen. Write the missing words to complete the text.
